TITLE: School Breakfast Program/National School Lunch Program; school boards to determine eligibility, etc.

SUMMARY: School boards; School Breakfast Program and National School Lunch Program; web-based application. Requires each local school board that collects information to determine eligibility for participation in the School Breakfast Program or the National School Lunch Program administered by the U.S. Department of Agriculture to establish and post prominently on its website a web-based application for student participation in such program and to continue to provide a paper-based application. The bill permits any school board in establishing such an application to adopt the U.S. Department of Agriculture's Web-Based Prototype Application for Free and Reduced Price School Meals or to digitize its existing paper-based application.

CHAPTER 228

[H 2400]

Approved March 5, 2019

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Virginia:

1. That the Code of Virginia is amended by adding a section numbered 22.1-207.2:1 as follows:

§ 22.1-207.2:1. School Breakfast Program and National School Lunch Program; web-based application.

Each local school board that collects information to determine eligibility for participation in the School Breakfast Program or the National School Lunch Program administered by the U.S. Department of Agriculture shall establish and post prominently on its website a web-based application for student participation in such program and shall continue to provide a paper-based application.

2. That any school board in establishing a web-based application to comply with the provisions of this act may adopt the U.S. Department of Agriculture's Web-Based Prototype Application for Free and Reduced Price School Meals or may digitize its existing paper-based application.
